SUBJECT: Temporary Suspension of CJA Payments
DATE: September 17, 2013

Effective Tuesday, September 17, 2013 the Fiscal Year 2013 funds for voucher payments have been exhausted. The result is a temporary suspension of payments beginning today and until Fiscal Year 2014 funding becomes available. My office will continue to receive and process payments as usual, and approved payments will be placed in the queue for disbursement. It is worth noting that this temporary suspension was delayed as a result of lower than planned payments submitted by panel attorneys.

RE: TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT PANEL ATTORNEY
PAYMENTS (**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**)

The fiscal year 2013 Defender Services financial plan assumed Criminal Justice Act (CJA) panel attorney payments would be suspended for the last three weeks in September 2013. Due to lower actual panel attorney payments than projected, we have been able to disburse payments beyond the point at which suspension was expected to begin. However, the funding provided for these payments has now been exhausted. As of September 17, 2013, all payments will be suspended and deferred until funding becomes available in fiscal year 2014. Assuming the continuation of government operations, the remaining 10 days of CJA panel attorney payments will be paid in full the week of October 1, 2013.

During this temporary suspension, judges should continue to appoint CJA panel attorneys for eligible defendants, authorize expert and other services as appropriate, and approve vouchers for payment as they were doing before payments were suspended. Courts and defender organizations should continue to process CJA vouchers submitted by panel attorneys, experts, service providers, court reporters, or for any other eligible CJA expense.

It should be noted that § 230.33 of the "Guidelines for Administering the CJA and Related Statutes" (Volume 7A, *Guide to Judiciary Policy*) provides that "Vouchers should not be delayed or reduced for the purpose of diminishing Defender Services program costs in response to adverse financial circumstances." Please note, all vouchers that are submitted will be paid when funding is available.
