Statler, Francisco B. Perez, Yuk Lan Moylan, and Irby John Baker. The defendants were charged with burglary in the first degree in an information filed on October 25, 1955. The jury acquitted the defendants that very same day. Mr. Richard Rosenberry, the Deputy Island Attorney, prosecuted the case, while Mr. Finton J. Phelan, Jr. was counsel of record for the defendants.
