Subject: Legal Public Holidays for Year 2010

In accordance with Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 6(a) and 77(c), the District Court of Guam will observe in the calendar year 2010 the following listed legal public holidays, as well as one local holiday, Liberation Day, listed under Section 1000, Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated:

New Year's Day - **Friday, January 1**  
Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr. - **Monday, January 18**  
Washington's Birthday - **Monday, February 15\***  
Memorial Day - **Monday, May 31**  
Independence Day - **Monday, July 5**  
Liberation Day - **Wednesday, July 21**  
Labor Day - **Monday, September 6**  
Columbus Day - **Monday, October 11**  
Veterans Day - **Thursday, November 11**  
Thanksgiving Day - **Thursday, November 25**  
Christmas Day - **Friday, December 24\*\***  
New Year's Day - **Friday, December 31\*\***

\* This holiday is designated as "Washington's Birthday" in section 6103(a) of title 5 of the United States Code, but other agencies and entities often refer to it as "President's Day".

\*\* December 25, 2010 (the legal public holiday for Christmas), falls on a Saturday, and January 1, 2011 (the legal public holiday for New Year's Day), falls on a Saturday.
