ASSISTANT U.S. BANKRUPTCY TRUSTEE ON GUAM
TO PRESENT BANKRUPTCY LAW AND TRENDS

Chief Judge Frances Tydingco-Gatewood and the Guam Bar Association are proud to welcome Mr. Curtis B. Ching, Assistant U.S. Trustee from Hawaii, to Guam. Mr. Ching will be on Guam to deliver a seminar on Tuesday, September 25, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., at the District Court of Guam. Mr. Ching will provide an overview of consumer bankruptcy law (Chapters 7 and 13), and the seminar will be offered free of charge (although Guam Bar members will be charged an administrative fee for educational credits). Mr. Ching has worked at the U.S. Trustee's Office, as a Trial Attorney and as an Assistant U.S. Trustee, for 22 years. While at the U.S. Trustee's Office, Mr. Ching's responsibilities has included coverage of Guam and CNMI bankruptcy cases. He has appeared in Guam bankruptcy cases over the years, including Ada's Incorporated, Hakubotan, The Doctor's Clinic, D.S. Corp. dba Bunny Markets, Cyfred, Ltd., and most recently the NMI Retirement Fund cases. Mr. Ching is a graduate of Stanford University and Boston College.



Mr. Ching has also been invited by Guam Chamber of Commerce President David Leddy to deliver the keynote address before the Guam Chamber of Commerce, at their membership luncheon to be held on Thursday, September 27, 2012, at the Oasis Ballroom, Onward Agana Beach Resort. Mr. Ching will speak on the subjects of bankruptcy law and trends on Guam and Hawaii.
