GENERAL ORDER OF COURT

No. 13-0008

In accordance with Section 2.8 of General Order No. 09-0008, *In Re: Attorney Admission Fund Plan*, hospitality items (e.g. food, beverages, mementos) for which appropriated funds may not be used, may be procured with attorney admission funds for purposes which inure to the benefit of the members of the bench and the bar in the administration of justice.

The court authorizes the Clerk of Court or her designee to establish an account with a local company for the sole purpose of procuring water and water bottles for use by bar members and judges while conducting business at the court, whether in court session, in a training session, in a court committee or similar meeting. The court finds that water is a hospitality item for which appropriated funds may not be used and that providing such item benefits the bench and bar in the administration of justice. The total amount of water and bottles procured shall not exceed \$200 without further authorization of the court.
