Before the court is a Joint Motion to Lift Stay and Enter Judgment. *See* ECF No. 41. Said motion is hereby **GRANTED**. The stay issued on May 10, 2013 (ECF No. 26) is hereby lifted. In addition, the Stipulation for Compromise Settlement (ECF No. 41, at 5-8) between the United States and Claimants Jovin Santos and Daelene Waki is hereby approved as submitted.

Whereas, the United States and Claimants Jovin Santos and Daelene Waki have entered into a Stipulation for Compromise Settlement concerning the above-entitled defendant property; and

Whereas, no other party has made a claim to or declared any interest in the above-described defendant *res*;

Now therefore, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that

1. Claimants Jovin Santos and Daelene Waki in Civil Case No. 12-00019, agree to withdraw their claims and release all right, title, and interest in certain defendant property, approximately \$43,871.00 in United States Currency, which shall be forfeited to and shall vest in the United States of America for disposition according to law.

- 1 2. In consideration, upon this court's order approving the compromise settlement in Civil
2 Case No. 12-00019, vesting approximately \$43,871.00 in the United States for
3 disposition according to law, and Ronita Cruz's written permission to release the
4 defendant property to claimants, the United States shall return to Claimants Jovin Santos
5 and Daelene Waki, by and through their attorney, David J. Lujan, the defendant property,
6 specifically: ONE 2007 CHEVROLET TAHOE LS, VIN 1GNFC13C37R360227.
- 7 3. All claims and interests in the defendant property, except as provided herein and in the
8 Stipulation for Compromise Settlement, are forever foreclosed and barred.
- 9 4. Each party shall bear their respective costs and attorney's fees.
- 10 5. The Clerk of the Court shall enter a judgment consistent with this order.
- 11 6. The United States may request, upon entry of judgment or at any time thereafter, a
12 certificate of reasonable cause under 28 U.S.C. Section 2465(a)(2).
- 13 7. The court shall retain jurisdiction in this case for the purpose of enforcing the terms of the
14 Stipulation for Compromise Settlement.
