LOCAL RULES OF PRACTICE REVISION
TO GR 7.1.

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 5(d)(3), Fed. R. Crim. P. 49(d) and Fed. R. Bankr. P. 5001, 5005(a)(2), and Local Rule GR 5.1, and LBR 5005-1,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that General Rule 7.1 of the Local Rules of Practice for the District Court of Guam is amended to require the use of the Court's Case Management/Electronic Filing System ("CM/ECF") for the filing of pleadings after the court's normal business hours. Accordingly, the amended rule will read as follows:

GR 7.1 Clerk of Court.

(a) Location and Hours.

(1) The Office of the Clerk of this Court shall be located at 520 West Soledad Avenue, Fourth Floor of the U.S. Courthouse, Room 460, in Hagåtña, Guam. The mailing address is 4th Floor, U.S. Courthouse, 520 West Soledad Avenue, Hagåtña, Guam 96910. The regular hours shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. each day except Saturdays, Sundays, legal holidays and other days or at times so ordered by the court. Nothing in this Rule precludes the filing of papers as provided in Rule 77, Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.


(2) Pleadings to be filed after December 31, 2009 and outside of the regular hours set forth in

1 GR 7.1(a)(1) shall be filed electronically using the court's Case Management/Electronic Case
2 Filing ("CM/ECF") System, pursuant to the court's published "Administrative Procedures for
3 Filing, Signing, Verification and Service of Documents by Electronic Means in Civil and
4 Criminal Cases" and "Administrative Procedures for Filing, Signing, Verification and Service
5 of Documents by Electronic Means in Bankruptcy Cases."

6 (b) Court Calendar. The Clerk shall publish the court's calendar on the court's public website
7 and shall, no later than Friday of each week, publish the court's calendar for the following
8 week on the public bulletin board of the District Court.
