This case is before the court on the Defendants' Motions to Suppress. *See* Docket Nos. 70 & 72. The court referred this matter to United States Magistrate Judge Joaquin V.E. Manibusan, Jr., who held an evidentiary hearings on December 12, 30, and 31, 2008. *See* Docket Nos. 139, 145 & 146. On February 10, 2009, the Magistrate Judge recommended that the motions be granted. *See* Docket No. 147. On March 2, 2009, the United States filed objections to the Report and Recommendation. *See* Docket No. 152. Finally, on March 11, 2009, Defendant Song Ja Cha filed a response to the United States' objection, in which Defendant In Han Cha joined on March 12, 2009. *See* Docket Nos. 157 & 158.

Under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the court may accept, reject, or modify in whole or in part the Magistrate Judge's recommendation, but must review *de novo* any part as to which an objection has been filed. Upon said review, the court finds that the objections to the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendations are not well-taken, and are hereby **OVERRULED**.
