Order re Report and Recommendation

Presently before the court is the Defendant’s Motion to Exclude Illegally Procured Evidence (“Motion”). *See* Def.s’ Mot., ECF No. 23. This matter was referred to the United States Magistrate Judge Joaquin V.E. Manibusan, Jr. who held an evidentiary hearing on January 10, 2012. *See* ECF Nos. 25 and 51, respectively. On February 17, 2012, the Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation, recommending that Defendant’s Motion be denied. *See* ECF No. 54. There has been no timely objection.

Under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the court may accept, reject or modify in whole or in part the Magistrate Judge’s recommendation. Having thoroughly considered the matter and relevant law, the court hereby adopts the Magistrate’s Report and Recommendation in full.¹
