A Limitation Complaint was filed on December 9, 2010 by Majestic Blue Fisheries, LLC, as owner of the F/V Majestic Blue (the “Limitation Complaint”). The Limitation Complaint seeks exoneration from or limitation of liability, pursuant to 46 U.S.C. §30501 *et seq.* and Rule F of the Supplemental Rules for Certain Admiralty and Maritime Claims for any loss, damage, death, injury, or claims caused by or resulting from the sinking on June 14, 2010 of the vessel MAJESTIC BLUE, as more fully described in the Limitation Complaint. Majestic Blue Fisheries LLC having agreed to provide security for costs and having filed a Declaration of Value of the value of its monetary interest in the vessel, and approved security thereon, all as required by the applicable rules and law.

NOW THEREFORE, upon request of Majestic Blue Fisheries, LLC,

(1) IT IS ORDERED that the sum of \$1,000.00 pursuant to LAR F.1, be accepted as security for costs in this matter and that the undertaking filed herein by Majestic Blue Fisheries

LLC and Assuranceforeningen Skuld in that amount be accepted as proper security for said costs and that said undertaking is approved as to form, quantum and surety.

(2) IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Declaration of Value of Majestic Blue Fisheries' monetary interest in the F/V Majestic Blue in the amount of Thirty-Three Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$33,500.00), and the undertakings filed herein by Majestic Blue Fisheries and Assuranceforeningen Skuld be accepted as security for value for the purpose of the limitation proceedings and that they be approved as to form, quantum and surety.

(3) IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any claimant who may properly become a party hereto may contest the amount of Majestic Blue Fisheries' interest in the F/V Majestic Blue as fixed in said Declaration of Value, and may move the Court for new appraisal of said interest, and may apply to have the amount increased or diminished, as the case may be, on determination of the Court for the amount of value of said interest.

(4) IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Notice of Complaint for Exoneration From or Limitation of Liability shall be issued under the seal of this Court to all parties asserting claims with respect to which the Limitation Complaint seeks exoneration or limitation, admonishing them to file their respective claims with the Clerk of Court for the United States District Court, District of Guam, in writing, and to serve on the attorneys for Majestic Blue Fisheries a copy thereof by March 30, 2012, or be defaulted; and further, if any claimant desires to contest either the right to exoneration from or the right to limitation of liability, the claimant shall file and serve on attorneys for Majestic Blue Fisheries an answer to the Limitation Complaint by March 30, 2012, unless their claim has included an Answer to the Limitation Complaint, so designated, or be defaulted.

(5) IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Majestic Blue Fisheries shall publish the aforesaid Notice Of Complaint for Exoneration From or Limitation of Liability in the form required by Supplemental Rule F once a week for four successive weeks prior to March 30, 2012 in the Pacific Daily News in accordance with General Rule 1.1(d)(4), and copies of the notice shall also be mailed in accordance with Supplemental Rule F.

(6) IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the commencement or further prosecution of any claim or action including CV-11-00034 now pending in this Court or other proceeding against Majestic Blue Fisheries or its property and/or the Underwriters for the F/V Majestic Blue, with respect to any claim for which Majestic Blue Fisheries seeks exoneration from or limitation of liability, including any claim arising out of or connected in any way with any loss, damage, death, injury or destruction resulting from the matters described in the Limitation Complaint are hereby enjoined, stayed and restrained until the Court shall order otherwise.

(7) IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Majestic Blue Fisheries shall make service of a conformed copy this Order as a restraining order by way of United States Mail, electronic service, or facsimile to the person or persons to be enjoined or restrained, or their respective attorneys, or alternatively, by hand delivery.
