10 The Grand Jury Panel's twelve (12) month term of service is set to expire on May  
11 11, 2020. The Court incorporates its prior findings regarding the global outbreak of  
12 Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and the current state of emergency declarations,  
13 guidelines and findings as set forth in its prior General Orders regarding the same. Pursuant  
14 to Section 10.3 of the Jury Plan for the District Court of Guam, the Court further finds that  
15 extending the Grand Jury Panel's term of service is in the best interest of the public in light  
16 of the ongoing global outbreak of COVID-19. The Grand Jury Panel's term of service is  
17 hereby extended for an additional six (6) months, to the full 18 month term provided by Fed.  
18 R. Crim. P. 6(g).
