**ORDER**

The United States Trustee has announced that meetings of creditors under Section 341(a) of the Bankruptcy Code that are scheduled to be held between March 18 and April 10, 2020 have been postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic and will be rescheduled at a later time.

Regarding Chapter 13 cases in which the meeting of creditors has been postponed as stated above, it is hereby ordered that the deadline for a creditor to file an action under Section 523(c) is extended to and including 60 days after the date first set for the rescheduled meeting of creditors.

Regarding Chapter 7 cases in which the meeting of creditors has been postponed as stated above, it is hereby ordered that the following deadlines are extended to and including 60 days after the date first set for the rescheduled meeting of creditors: (1) deadline to bring action for exception to discharge under Section 523(c); (2) deadline to bring action to deny discharge under Section 727(a); and (3) deadline to bring motion to dismiss for abuse under Section 707(b)(3).
