THEME: The Constitution.

Articles One (I) through Seven (VII); The Bill of Rights (Amendments One (I) through Ten (X)); and/or Other Amendments (Eleven (XI) through Twenty-Seven (XXVII))

All students in elementary, middle and high school are eligible to participate. There will be a winner for each category.



JUDGING CRITERIA

1. THEME (40 points) Drawings MUST portray any part of the theme.
2. REFLECTION & MEANING OF DRAWING (30 possible points) (a.) You MUST indicate in writing, somewhere on your drawing, which part of the Constitution you have drawn; and (b.) What your drawing means to you (no more than 100 words);
3. CREATIVITY (20 possible points); and
4. ORIGINALITY (10 possible points).

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Each student is only allowed to submit one (1) entry.
2. Drawings will be accepted only on an 8.5 x 11 size paper.
3. Drawings must be hand-drawn – no digital drawing will be accepted.
4. Drawings may be done by: pencils, crayons, markers, pens, watercolors, charcoal, or paint.
5. Entries SHALL NOT include any drawings that are considered offensive in any nature (i.e. depicting nudity, obscene language, etc.)
6. All entries must be accompanied by a signed Participant Release Form. The Participant Release Form will also provide us with information needed when winners are announced and contacted.
7. Entries will not be accepted without a Participant Release Form.
8. Entries must be delivered to the District Court of Guam on Friday, September 27, 2019, no later than 11:00 a.m., Chamorro Standard Time.

SURPRISE GIFTS WILL BE AWARDED TO WINNERS. Winners will be announced on Monday, September 30, 2019.
