⊗ Complete application for Marijuana License Application

⊗ Filing Marijuana License Application

⊗ Represent a business as the designated agent for service

⊗ Draft and negotiate contracts with vendors for resources and supplies related to operations of marijuana business

⊗ Draft and negotiate lease agreement or purchase agreement for property to be used in cultivation, processing or sale of marijuana

⊗ Incorporation and/or entity formation for business with purpose of cultivating, processing or sale of marijuana

☑ Explain the current conflict between Guam and federal law

☑ Legal Opinion on legality and consequences of client's proposed conduct

☑ Explain the validity, scope and application of both state and federal

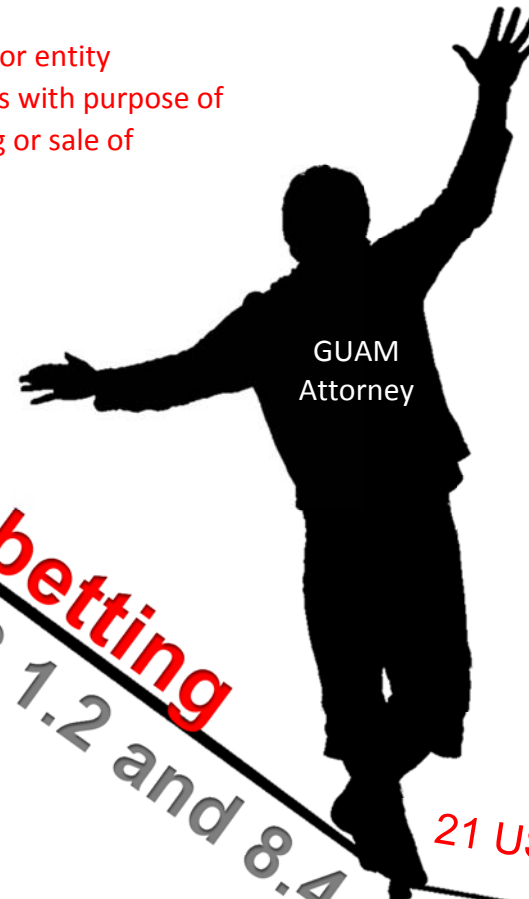
☑ Explain consequences of engaging in conduct that is permissible under Guam but contrary to federal law
