DISTRICT COURT OF GUAM APPOINTS FIRST DEPUTY CHIEF U.S. PROBATION OFFICER

Grace Damian Flores to be Sworn in on May 21, 2009

Munson of the District Court of the Northern Mariana Islands and Chief U.S. Probation Officer Rossanna Villagomez-Aguon are pleased to announce the appointment of Grace Damian Flores as the Deputy Chief U.S. Probation Officer for the district courts of Guam and the Northern Mariana Islands. This is a historical event as Ms. Flores will serve as the first Deputy Chief for the districts.

Prior to her appointment, Ms. Flores served as a U.S. Probation Officer for ten years with the United States Probation Office for the Districts of Guam and the Northern Mariana Islands. In her capacity as a probation officer, Ms. Flores served as the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Treatment Coordinator and the coordinator for the newly-created Prugraman Hinalom Talo (Drug Offender Re-entry Program).

Born and raised on Guam, Ms. Flores graduated from Notre Dame High School. She has a Bachelor of Criminal Justice degree and a certificate in Alcohol and Drug Studies from Seattle University, and a Master of Management degree from the University of Phoenix.
