

Documents that will be needed by recently U.S. Naturalized Citizens

Social Security Administration

To update SSA records to show U.S citizenship (already have a Social Security number):

Certificate of Naturalization or Certificate of Citizenship, and
Current Identification Card

To update SSA records due to name change during Naturalization (already have a Social Security number):

Certificate of Naturalization or Certificate of Citizenship, and
Name change certificate/order, and
Current Identification Card

To request for a Social Security number (never had a Social Security number):

Certificate of Naturalization or Certificate of Citizenship, and
Current Identification Card
Birth Certificate, if available

Guam Election Commission

To register to vote in a Guam election:

Certificate of Naturalization and a picture identification card
or
Copy of Birth Certificate and a picture identification card.

Guam Passport Office

To apply for a U.S. passport (adult*):

Social Security Number must be provided AND

Primary Evidence of U.S. Citizenship (one of the following)

Naturalization Certificate, or
Certified birth certificate, or
Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certification of Birth, or
Certificate of Citizenship

AND

Primary Evidence of Identification (one of the following)

Valid Driver's license, or
Naturalization Certificate, or
Current Government ID (local or federal), or
Current Military ID (military and dependent)

AND

Two (2) Passport Photos

AND

Payment of applicable fee

*There are special requirements for minors under age 16, and for minors ages 16 and 17.
