**ORDER REGARDING JUDICIAL  
SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE AND  
FOLLOW-UP STATUS CONFERENCE**

Counsel for the parties appeared for a status conference regarding settlement on October 19, 2017. Defendant Guam Education Board (Board) represented it has reached tentative agreement with Plaintiff but continues to wait on legislative approval of certain terms. Defendants Chargualaf and San Nicolas represented they have also reached

1 tentative agreement with Plaintiff, but a draft agreement had only recently been circulated.  
2 Defendants Cruz and Tainatongo, by the end of the hearing, represented that they too have  
3 reached tentative agreement with Plaintiff, but a finalized agreement remains to be  
4 circulated.

6 In the interest of encouraging the parties to expedite finalization of these  
7 agreements, the court **ORDERED** Plaintiff and the individual defendants to participate in  
8 a judicial settlement conference with Senior Judge Alex Munson on **Thursday, October**  
9 **26, 2017, at 1:45 p.m.** The court noted the conference may be vacated upon notice, filed  
10 with the court, that all parties have reached final agreement.  
11

12 The Board requested a follow-up status conference, to be held in sixty days, to report  
13 on any updates regarding legislative approval. The court set a **hearing** for **Wednesday,**  
14 **December 20, 2017, at 8:30 a.m.**
