GENERAL ORDER 21-0009


WHEREAS, there are currently in the Qualified Jury Wheel, One-Thousand Two-Hundred (1,200) prospective jurors as required by the Jury Selection and Service Act of 1968, as Amended, and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to create a new Pool to appear for jury service on May 18, 2021 at 8:00 a.m. The term of service for the Pool shall not exceed the length of said trial or a period of sixty days, whichever is longer, unless extended by Court.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that on Wednesday, May 5, 2021, the Clerk of Court or her designated deputy clerks shall withdraw, by a purely randomized method, One-Hundred (100) names from the Qualified Jury Wheel who will be summoned for jury service on Tuesday, May 18, 2021 at 8:00 a.m.

A copy of this order shall be posted on the Court's bulletin board.
