GENERAL ORDER 20-0002

WHEREAS, there are currently in the Qualified Jury Wheel, One-Thousand Eight-Hundred Forty (1,840) prospective jurors as required by the Jury Selection and Service Act of 1968, as Amended, and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to create two new Pools to appear for jury service on February 3, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. The term of service for the Pool shall not exceed the length of said trial or a period of thirty days, whichever is longer, unless extended by the Court.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that on Thursday, January 23, 2020, the Clerk of Court or her designated deputy clerks shall withdraw, by a purely randomized method, One-Hundred Fifty (150) names from the Qualified Jury Wheel, Seventy-Five (75) per Pool, who will be summoned for jury service on Monday, February 3, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

A copy of this order shall be posted on the Court's bulletin board.
