
GENERAL ORDER

**CRLR 4 Summons**

No later than two business days upon the courts grant of a request to issue a summons for a defendant in a criminal case, a proposed summons utilizing the AO 83 Form shall be submitted to the Clerk's Office by the requesting agency and shall include information for service as set forth on page 2 of the AO 83 Form. Failure to comply with this rule may result in non-issuance of the summons by the Clerk's Office or the non-service by the United States Marshals Service.
