In Re: Exemption from the Electronic Public
Access Fees for Kathlyn Selleck, Chapter 7
Bankruptcy Trustee

GENERAL ORDER NO. 20-0028

The Court finds that Kathlyn Selleck, Chapter 7 bankruptcy trustee for the District of Guam, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Accordingly, Kathlyn Selleck shall be exempt for the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court for bankruptcy files, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of her duties as a Chapter 7 bankruptcy trustee and including any such fees she incurred since being appointed the Chapter 7 bankruptcy trustee for the District of Guam. She shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court.

Additionally, the following limitations apply:

1. This fee exemption applies only to Kathlyn Selleck, Chapter 7 bankruptcy trustee for Guam, and is valid for only for the purposes stated above;
2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system;
3. By accepting this exemption Kathlyn Selleck agrees not to sell for profit any data

This exemption is valid until further order of the Court and may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
