GENERAL ORDER 21-0014

WHEREAS, there are currently in the Qualified Jury Wheel, One-Thousand One-Hundred Eleven (1,111) prospective jurors as required by the Jury Selection and Service Act of 1968, as Amended, and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to create a new Pool to appear for jury service on July 13, 2021 at 8:00 a.m. The term of service for the Pool shall not exceed the length of said trial or a period of sixty days, whichever is longer, unless extended by Court.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that on Thursday, July 1, 2021, the Clerk of Court or her designated deputy clerks shall withdraw, by a purely randomized method, One-Hundred (100) names from the Qualified Jury Wheel who will be summoned for jury service on Tuesday, July 13, 2021 at 8:00 a.m.

A copy of this order shall be posted on the Court's bulletin board.
