**ORDER AUTHORIZING EXEMPTION
FROM PACER FEES FOR BANKRUPTCY TRUSTEE**

WHEREAS, the Judicial Conference of the United States has prescribed fees for public access to court electronic records (“PACER”), as scheduled in the Appendix to 28 U.S.C. Section 1930, and

WHEREAS, the schedule provides that the court may exempt persons or classes of persons from the fees in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to such information, and

WHEREAS, the provision specifically identifies bankruptcy trustees as persons who may be exempted from the payment of fees for the use of PACER,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that **PACER account number rbehawaii** used by **RICHARD EMERY, Subchapter V Trustee**, shall be exempt in this district from the electronic public access fees set forth in the Appendix to 28 U.S.C. Section 1930, and any related fees for use of PACER for performing duties as a bankruptcy trustee effective March 29, 2022.

This order shall be filed *nunc pro tunc* to March 29, 2022.
