**GENERAL ORDER 26-0004**

WHEREAS there are currently in the Qualified Jury Wheel, Two-Thousand Three-Hundred Twenty-Eight (2,328) prospective jurors as required by the Jury Selection and Service Act of 1968, as Amended, and,

WHEREAS it is necessary to create a new Pool to appear for jury service on March 17, 2026, at 8:00 a.m. The term of service for the Pool shall not exceed the length of said trial or a period of sixty days, whichever is longer, unless extended by Court.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that on Wednesday, February 25, 2026, the Clerk of Court or her designated deputy clerks shall withdraw, by a purely randomized method, One Hundred (100) names from the Qualified Jury Wheel who will be summoned for jury service on Tuesday, March 17, 2026, at 8:00 a.m.

A copy of this order shall be posted on the Court's bulletin board.
